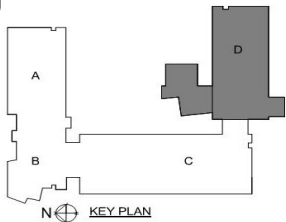

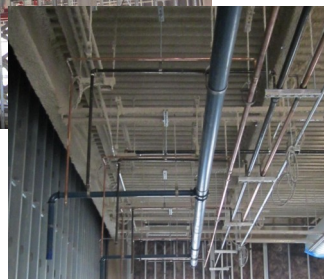
The Breakdown

Right; The monumental stairs in the Atrium (Area B) begin installation. These stairs will be one of the main focal points of the atrium.



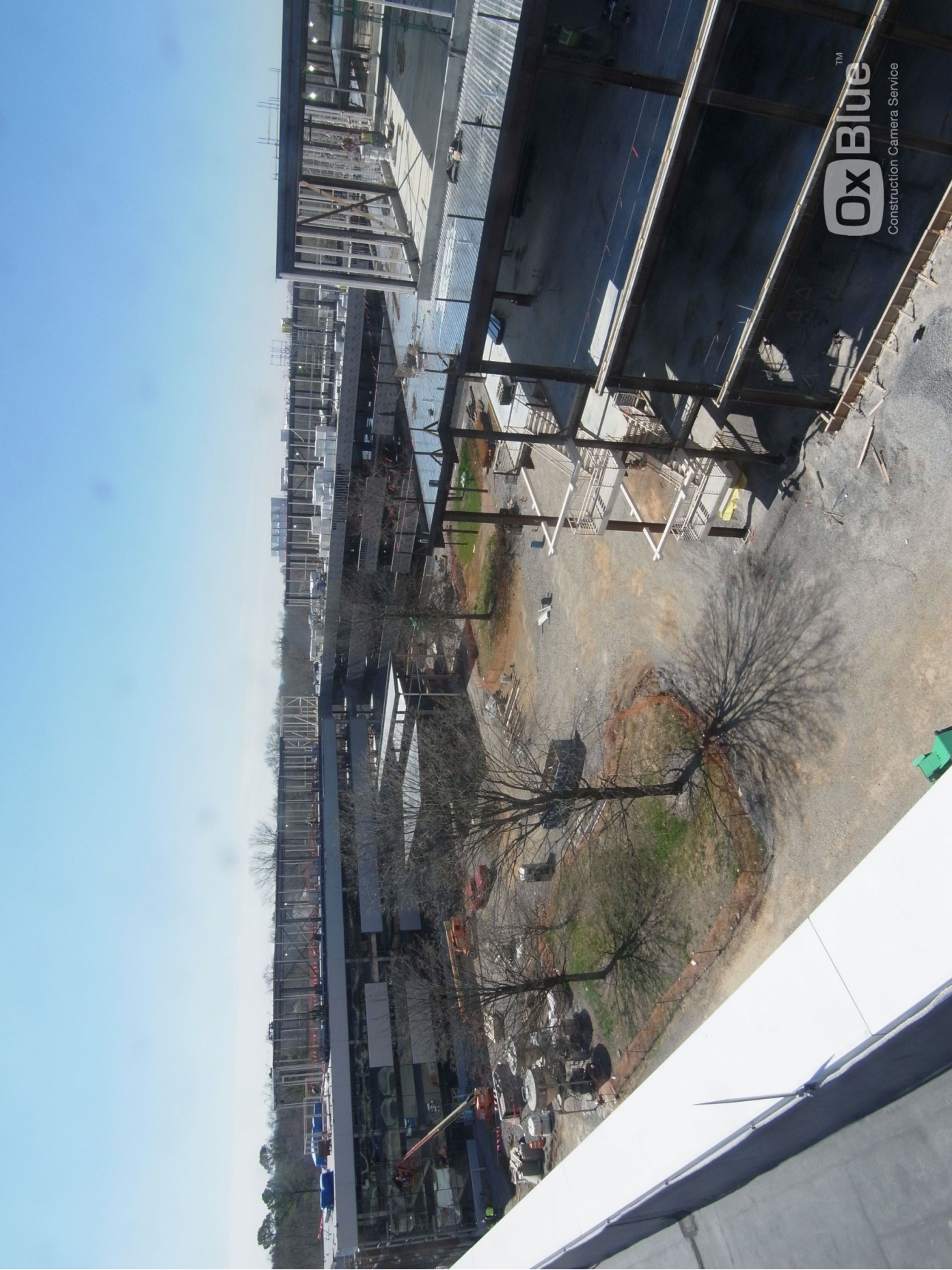

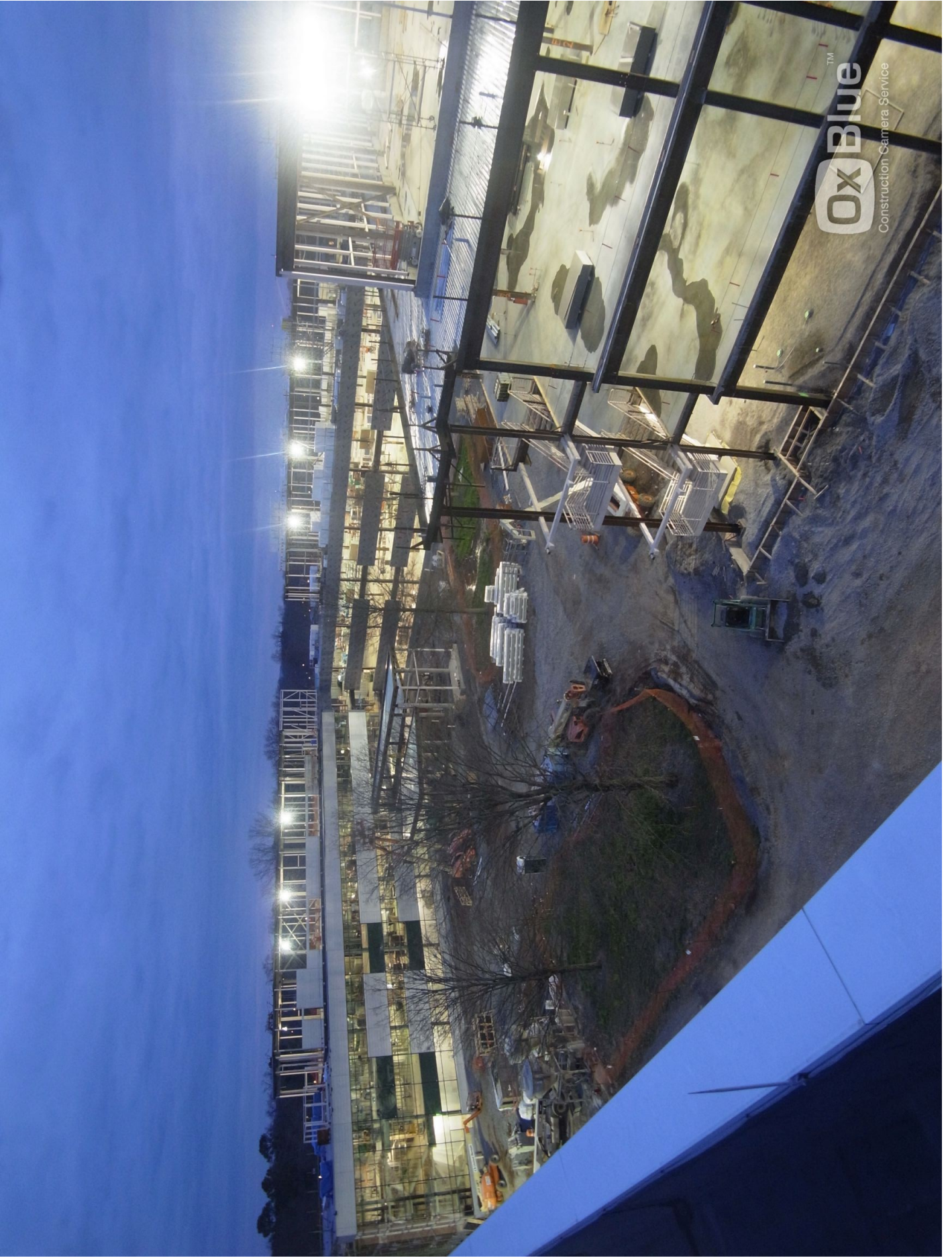
