

FY25 CBAS Proposal and Grant Award Activity Report

Historical Comparison

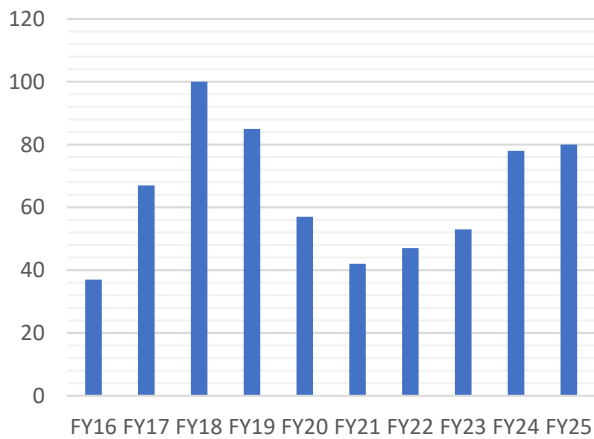


Figure 2: Proposal Funds Requested

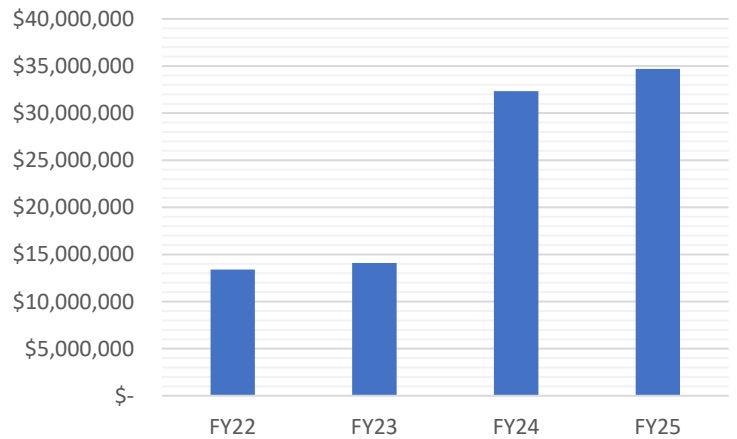


Figure 3: Grants Awarded

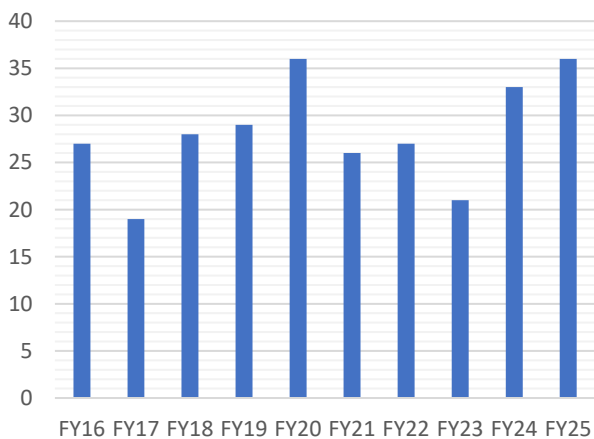
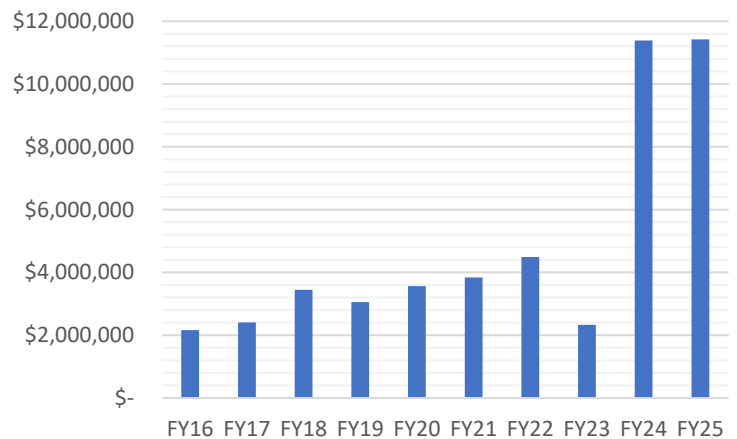


Figure 4: Total New Grant Funding

Number of proposals submitted (80; *Figure 1*) and number of grants awarded (36; *Figure 3*) were similar to FY24 numbers and above the previous 5-year averages (proposals = 55; grant awards = 29). Funds requested through proposals in FY25 (\$34,687,697; *Figure 2*) were up slightly from FY24 and up over 2-fold compared to FY23 and FY22. Several large dollar grants were awarded in Physics, Agriculture, STEM Education, and biomedical research. The total new funding for FY25 was similar to FY24, remaining up substantially over previous years. (*Figure 4*). Altogether, \$11,418,263 in new funding was awarded in FY25 compared to a previous 5-year average of \$5,121,418.

Proposal Analysis by Administrative Unit

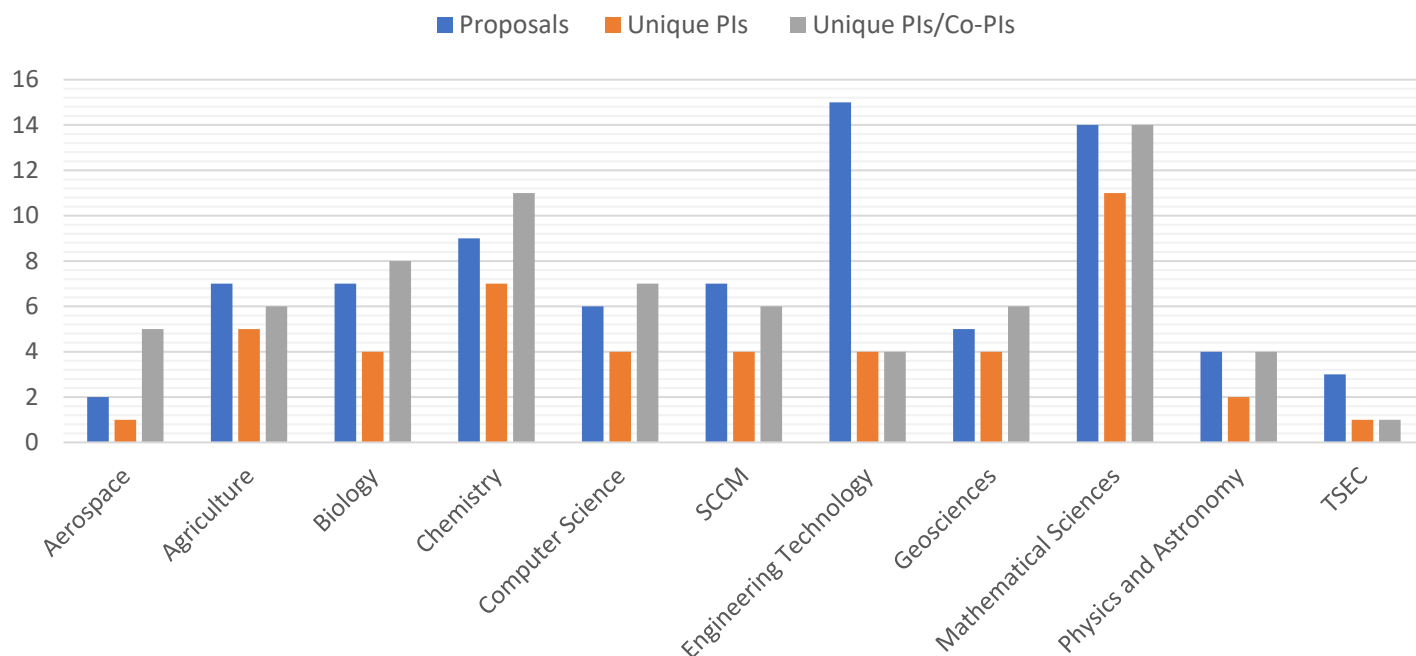
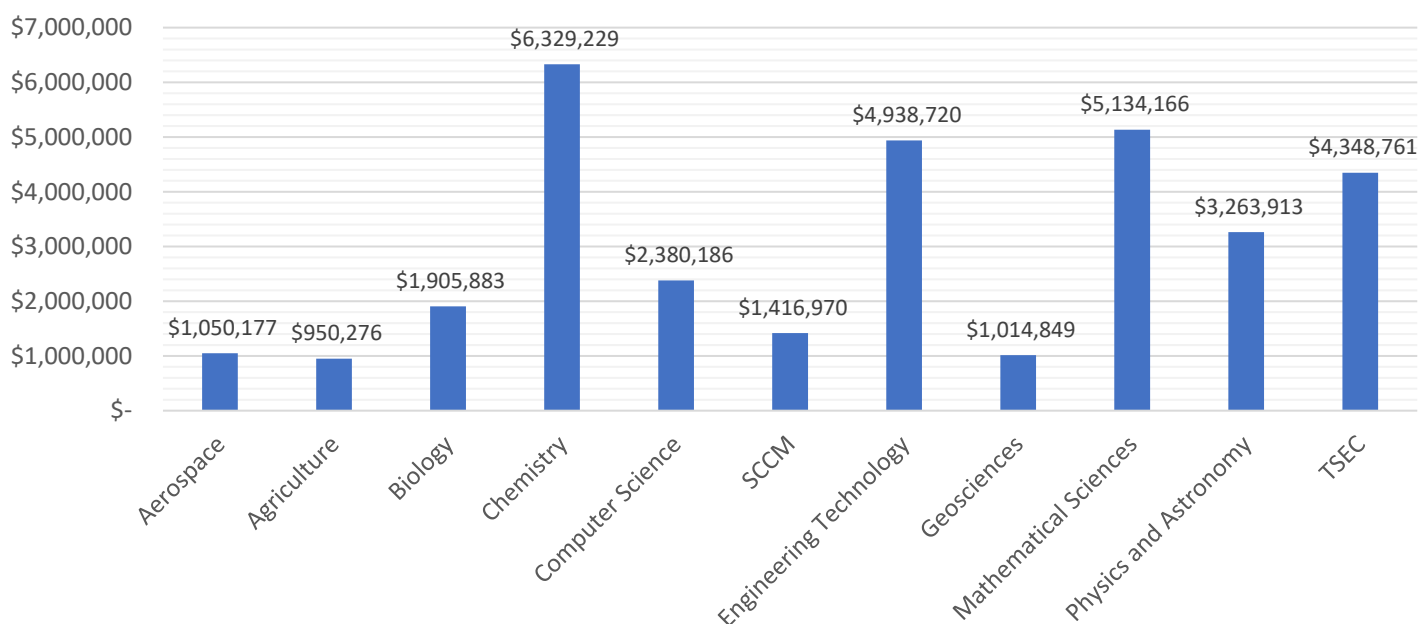


Figure 6: FY25 Proposals - Proposal Funding Requested by Administrative Unit

A total of 47 unique faculty from eleven different CBAS administrative units served as PI on grant proposals in FY25. Altogether 72 unique CBAS faculty served as either PI or Co-PI on a grant proposal in FY25. A breakdown of proposal numbers, unique PIs, and unique PIs/Co-PIs by administrative unit can be found in *Figure 5*. Proposal funding requested by each administrative unit can be found in *Figure 6*.

Figure 5: FY25 Proposals - Proposals, PIs, Co-PIs by Administrative Unit

Grant Award Analysis by Administrative Unit

A total of 32 unique faculty from ten different CBAS administrative units served as PI on grants awarded in FY25. Altogether 47 unique CBAS faculty served as either PI or Co-PI on a grant awarded in FY25. A breakdown of grant award numbers, unique PIs, and unique PIs/Co-PIs by administrative unit can be found in *Figure 7*. Figure 7: FY25 Awards - Awards, PIs, Co-PIs by Administrative Unit

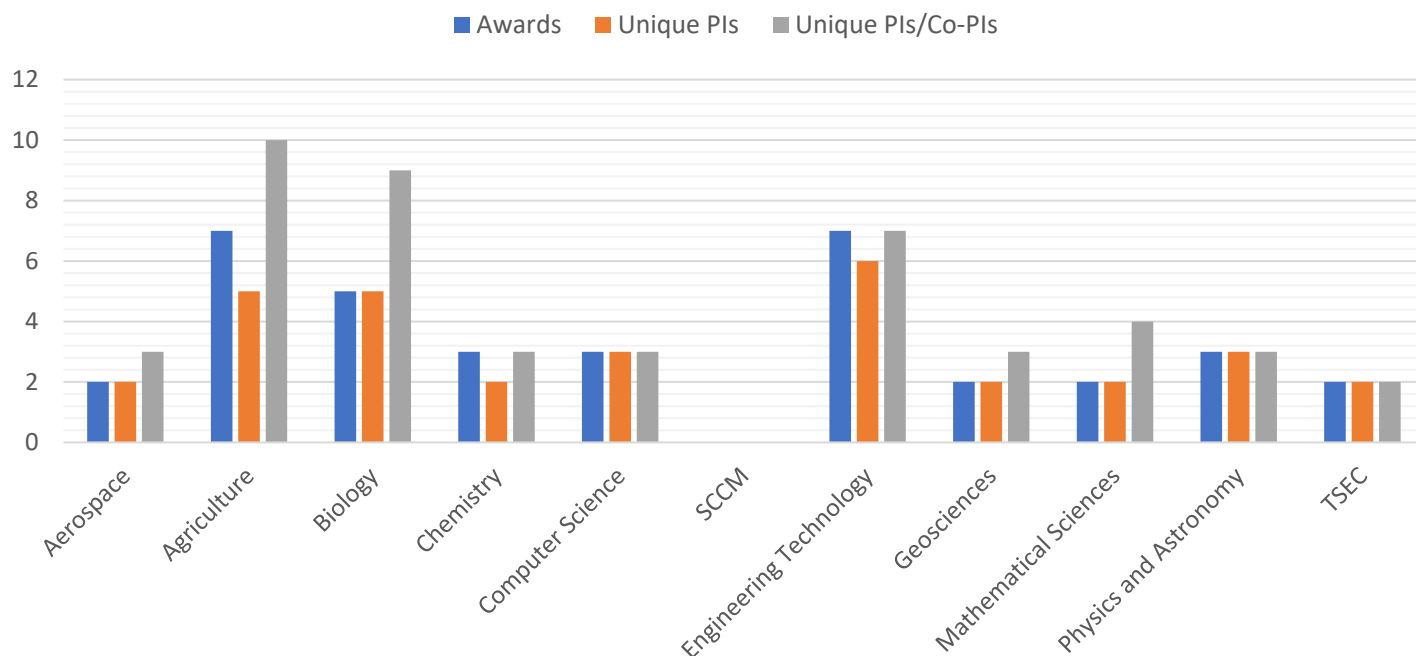
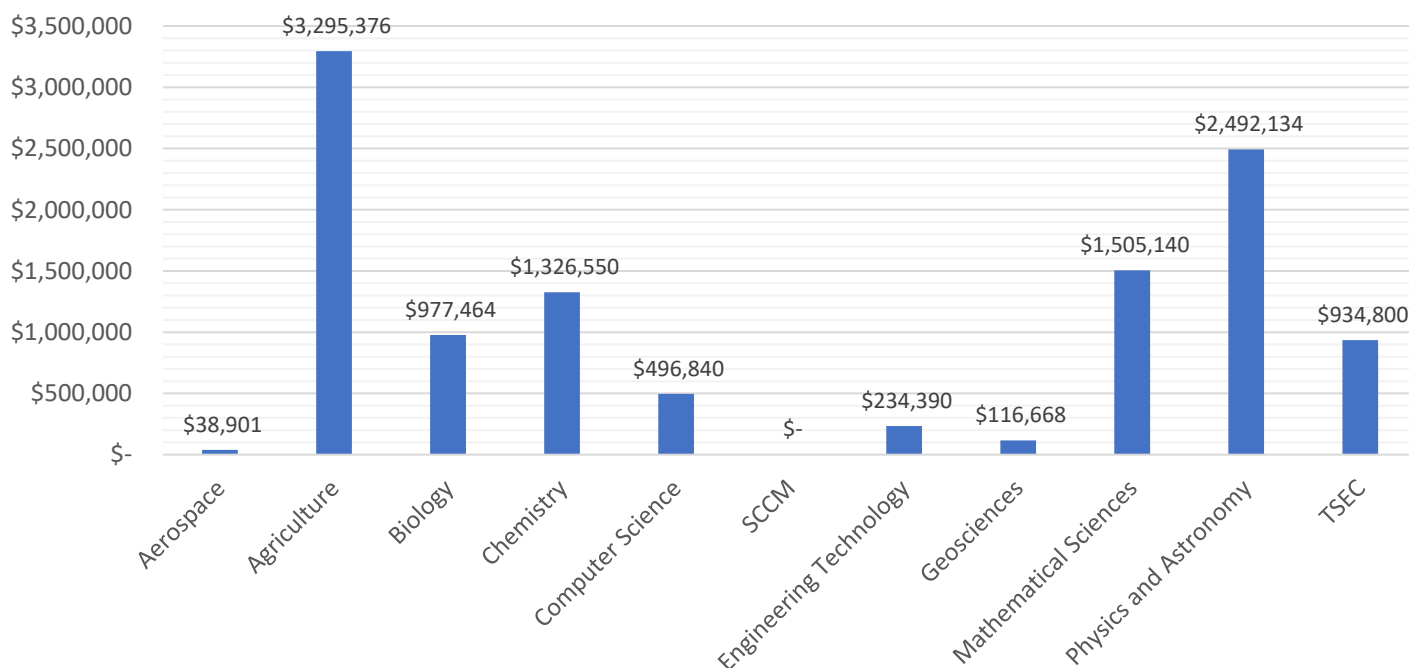
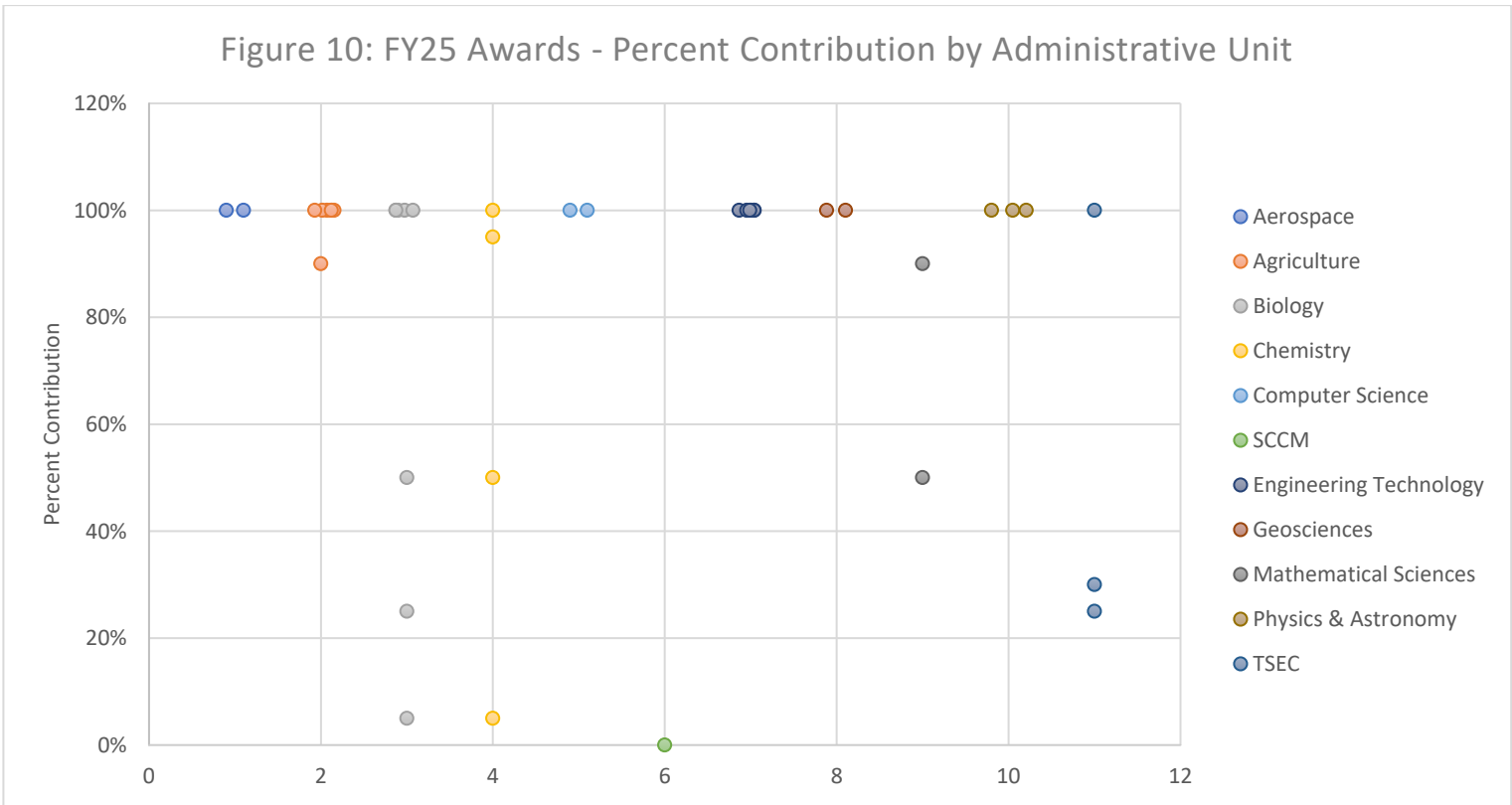
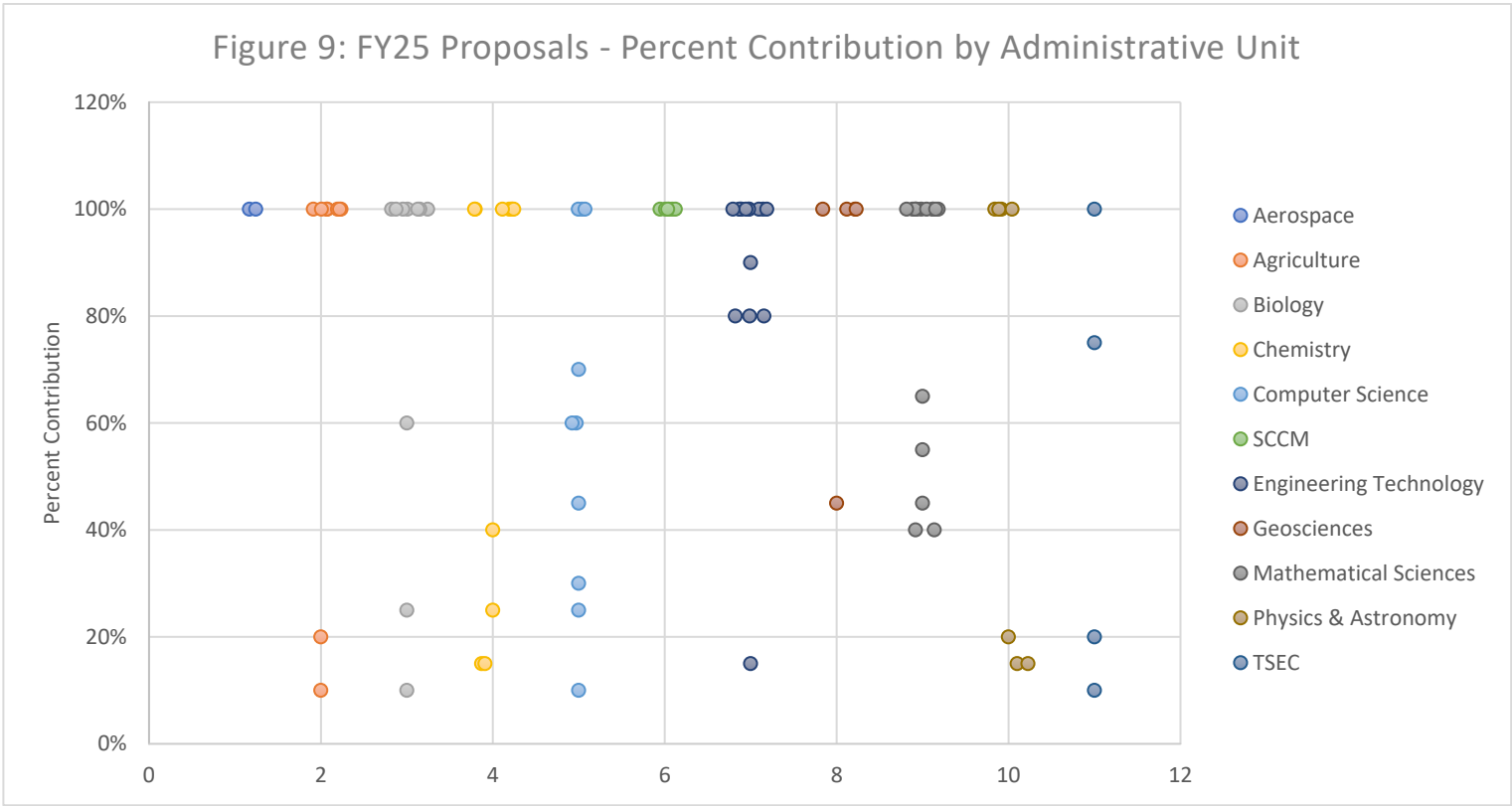


Figure 8: FY25 Awards - External Funding by Administrative Unit

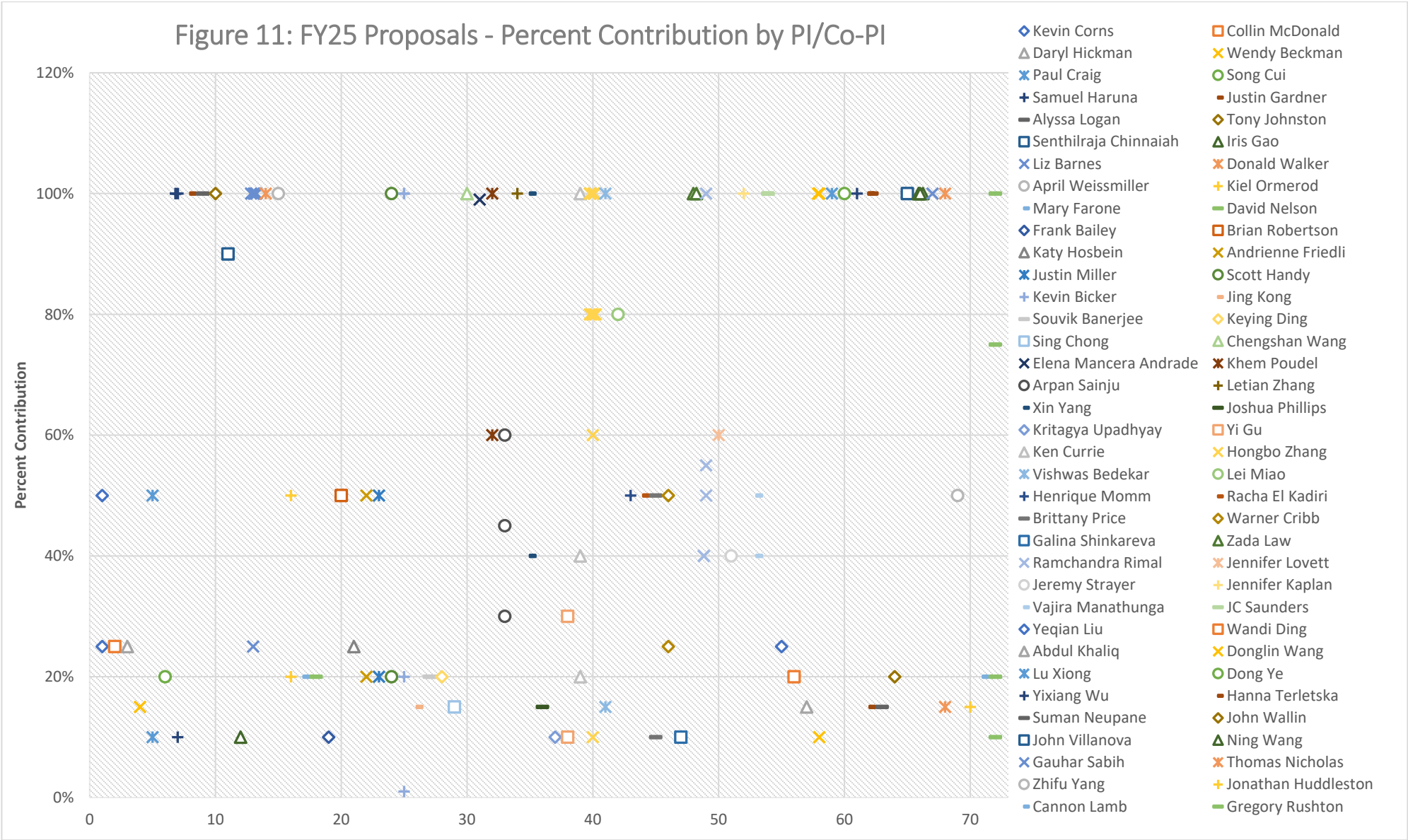


Figure 12: FY25 Awards - Percent Contribution by PI/Co-PI
